HOW THE REGISTRY WORKS

The information you provide in the SNR can save precious time in an emergency and help deputies do their job.

The SNR provides deputies with:

- A photograph and description of the person with special needs.
- Contact information for caregivers and doctors.
- Medical, safety and behavioral concerns.
- Accommodations for interacting and communicating with the person.
- Information needed to find a missing person or identify someone who is found.
